



Defiance, Henry, Fulton, Paulding Williams and Van Wert

2021 Winter Crisis Program Starts November 1!

The Northwestern Ohio Community Action Commission of Defiance, Williams, Fulton, Henry, Paulding, and Van Wert Counties is announcing the 2021 WINTER CRISIS PROGRAM. The Winter Crisis Program is a heating assistance program that may provide a one-time payment toward a utility and/ or bulk service for those who meet the program eligibility requirements. The Program begins November 1, 2020 and runs through March 31, 2021.

Services Available:

- A payment towards utility service that is currently off or in disconnection status;
- A payment to establish new service;
- Possible furnace repair up to \$500.00
- Bulk fuel delivery (propane, fuel oil, wood, coal). Must have 25% or less fuel in tank.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Eligible applicant's total household income must be at or below 175% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines: See chart at right.
- **If you or a household member have been diagnosed with COVID, no disconnection notice is needed.**

All applicants also MUST provide the following documentation when coming to the appointment:

- Proof of all income for the previous 30 days. (Includes Wages, Self-employment, Odd Jobs, Social Security, SSI, Unemployment, Seasonal, Wages, ect.)
- **BOTH** electric and gas bills.
- Proof of disability (if applicable)
- Social Security cards and birthdates of **ALL** members in the household
- Health Insurance Premiums paid or Child Support paid
