## *Minutes DEFIANCE TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES FEBRUARY* 9<sup>TH</sup>, 2010 MEETING

The presentation also noted that only First Energy of Ohio customers are affected by the program. If citizens approve the ballot issue the County Commissioners would act as the coordinating entity; citizens could expect to get a \$30 to \$60 annual reduction in their elect bills, the Twp would acquire a one time grant from First Energy of approximately \$16,667, the County would acquire a one time grant from First Energy of approximately up to \$79,163 (dependent on the number of Townships present that would approved the ballot issue); First Energy acquires a nine year agreement.

Following the presentation no action was taken as Trustees await a draft resolution which would place the issue on the May ballot.

The meeting adjourned.
